<b>Course Information</b>	<p><a href="http://www.upv.es/entidades/OPII/infoweb/pi/info/818871normali.html">http://www.upv.es/entidades/OPII/infoweb/pi/info/818871normali.html</a> Important information when selecting courses: READ CAREFULLY!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students generally should take around 30 credits per semester, and in any case, a minimum of 20 credits is required (the minimum can vary according to the school)</li> <li>• Some Schools may have some pre-requisites concerning course selection. In that case these pre-requisites will be announced in the online application form under instructions. Additionally some courses may also have pre-requisites which must be considered before making a selection. Insufficient background may result into course denial.</li> <li>• Hosting schools can only guarantee for acceptance in their own courses. Enrolment in courses outside the hosting schools will depend on the spaces available after registering their own students.*</li> <li>• It is important to make sure that the selected courses are taught in the semester the student is to come.</li> <li>• When selecting courses students should bear in mind that EPSA and EPSG are located in the cities of Alcoy and Gandia respectively (around 80km from Valencia)</li> <li>• Class availability cannot be confirmed until enrolment once students have arrived in UPV.</li> </ul> <p>Students will have 10 days after the beginning of the semester to make changes in their course selection. *Some Schools may have very limited spaces due to huge demand. Enrolment at the Faculty of Business Administration and Management is not guaranteed</p> <p>Please be aware that there are some programs or courses that have restrictions. Please notice that Schengen Visa doesn't carry the NIE.
