# The Symposium Problematic:

The Algerian city is currently experiencing great imbalances caused mainly by urban sprawl in all directions. The nature of these imbalances indicates that we are not facing simple and logical urban extensions of existing cities, but the emergence of urban entities in total rupture with existing urban fabrics, thus creating serious social, cultural and environmental.

The programmatic vision of town planning, based on quantitative objectives, which has always prevailed (housing and equipment programs), has not been able to integrate the cultural references of the population and the aesthetic aspects of the built environment. This gave birth to large heterogeneous urban complexes without architectural cachet and without soul and where the cultural dimension is almost absent.

It is established that architecture is a socio-cultural (intangible) product more than a material product. Thus allowing continuity over time through the interaction of symbols from the past and their openness to the present. It is the product of a society that expresses its worldview, culture and aspirations. Indeed, architectural diversity traces, according to Ibn Khaldoun, the various events that have occurred during the history of society as well as its traditions and customs.

The city performs various economic, administrative, social, political, cultural functions which allow urbanity and relatively harmonious collective life. It is not a lifeless habitat zone.

The Algerian city as it was conceived and built has created a real break with the population that occupies it. This degradation of urban space has generated, in turn, a deterioration of social relations and, therefore, a climate of hostility, which has led to a multitude of negative urban phenomena such as the proliferation of waste and illegal dumping, the scarcity of green spaces and the spread of urban violence in all its forms.

The previously mentioned elements lead us to think that with an approach that is both multidisciplinary and interdisciplinary (social sciences, urban planning and architecture), we must rethink and reinvent the city. And this, in order to humanize the latter through actions in support of social development, better architectural design in order to make these human settlements that are cities more human and therefore more pleasant to live in.

### The objectives of the conference:

This conference aims to identify the possibilities of convergence and the meeting points between the different scientific disciplines: sociology, anthropology, demography, history, the arts, town planning, architecture in the study of the city.

The aim is to identify the links between the different scientific fields and the town planning and architectural design offices with a view to establishing a common ground where the opinions of all the players in the field intersect. urban fact, but in addition to revitalize the cultural heritage, the true soul of these constructions.
