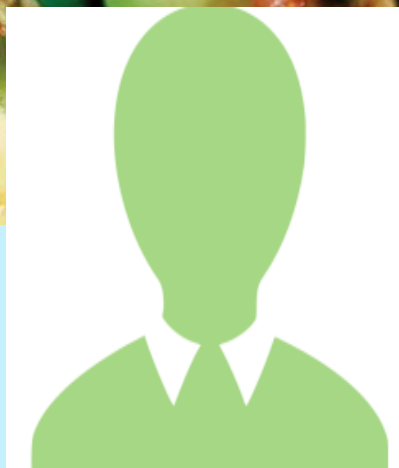
What is a Microbiota? Why are researchers interested in the intestinal microbiota? What are its functions in the body and its interactions with our diet and health?

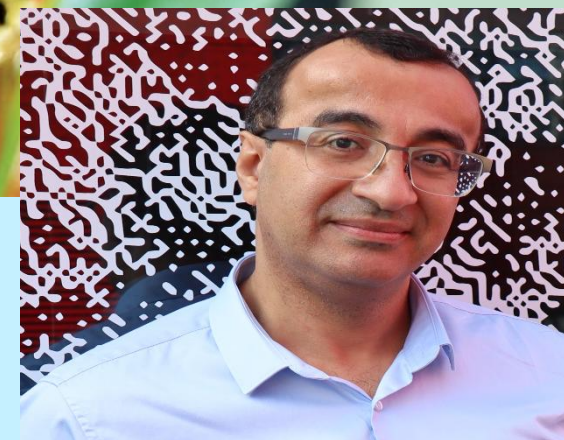
Food poisoning and mycotoxins toxicity: What are the useful tools endorsed in the protection and/or the prevention of diseases resulted from the consumption of contaminated food?
