### Background

Algeria's heritage, a living testimony to the history, culture, and identity of a nation rich in diversity, stands as a bridge between past and present. In a context where the preservation and enhancement of these legacies are of utmost importance ; our national symposium provides an essential forum for exchange. Researchers, practitioners, and enthusiasts will meet to discuss the challenges and opportunities associated with this crucial mission.

Heritage preservation transcends material conservation; it touches the very essence of the soul and national memory. How can we pass on these treasures to future generations, while dynamically integrating them into a modern society on the move?

This symposium will offer an interdisciplinary space for dialogue, bringing together experts in archaeology, history, architecture, art, anthropology, and tourism. These innovative minds will explore strategic approaches to restoring, protecting and promoting diverse elements of heritage, from archaeological sites to intangible cultural expressions.

Particular attention will be paid to the case of the Tidjiddit site, which has attracted the interest of specialists. However, despite its legal classification, destruction persists. Associations have tried preserving this heritage, but problems remain: ownership of the houses, lack of funds for restoration, and difficulties in involving the inhabitants.

In addition, we will explore how heritage enhancement can strengthen national and regional identity, alongside the promotion of sustainable and respectful tourism. Proposals addressing contemporary issues, such as the use of technology for preservation, community involvement and heritage education, are strongly encouraged.

### AREAS FOR REFLECTION

The proposed themes for the symposium are as follows:

- 1) Towards a better understanding of the old medina: identify historic sites, Drawing up an exhaustive inventory,
- 2) Rehabilitation, research, and restoration: Experiences and work in heritage preservation in Algeria,
- 3) Critical analysis of legislation on the rehabilitation and restoration of historic sites: proposals for enrichment and improvement.
- 4) **Tidjiddit's Art Project:** an artistic initiative aimed at raising public awareness of the importance of the heritage of the Old Town of Mostaganem through representative and creative exhibitions and video projections.
- 5) **Tidjiddit:** an immaterial and spiritual space

### 2 lines of spacing

Begin the text of the abstract with the text in Times New Roman font size 12 pt with 1.5 lines of spacing (normal style).  
The paper must not exceed 10 pages.
