

However, the reality of local development has been exposed to difficulties mainly due to central decisions.

After carrying out an organizational reform of local administration through the promulgation of laws 90/08 and 90/09, to reduce the centralization of decision-making and grant the municipality, in particular, legal and institutional mechanisms, allowing it to have a margin of initiative and independence.

The promulgation of Law 11/10, to address the crisis of managing the financial deficit of municipalities, by integrating modern approaches and approaches to management and management of regional groups, focused mainly on governance and sustainable development.

We are witnessing a reflection on contemporary mechanisms and methods, particularly in the current circumstances, characterized by a crisis unprecedented in decades.
