

Abstract Style and Format for the 1st International Conference on Industrial Systems and Energy (ICISE 2025)

To ensure consistency and professionalism across all submissions for the 1st International Conference on Industrial Systems and Energy (ICISE 2025) in Mostaganem, Algeria, please adhere to the following abstract style and format guidelines:

1. General Information

- Length : The abstract should not exceed 250 words.
- Language: English (as per the conference's official language).
- Font: Times New Roman, font size 12.
- Spacing: Single-spaced with 1-inch margins on all sides.
- Alignment: Justified alignment.

2. Structure of the Abstract

Title

- Format: Bold, centered, title case (capitalize major words).

Author(s) Information

- Include the full name(s) of the author(s), affiliation(s), and email address(es).
- Use a smaller font size (11) for this section.

Body of the Abstract

- Clearly structured into the following components:
 - 1. Introduction:** Briefly introduce the topic and its significance.
 - 2. Objective:** State the aim or purpose of the research.
 - 3. Methods:** Describe the methodology or approach used.
 - 4. Results:** Summarize key findings or outcomes.
 - 5. Conclusion:** Highlight the implications or contributions of the study.

Keywords

- Provide six to eight keywords relevant to your research topic.
- Keywords should be italicized and separated by commas.

3. Formatting Rules

- Avoid using abbreviations unless they are widely recognized.
- Do not include figures, tables, or references within the abstract.
- Use clear and concise language.
- Ensure that the abstract is self-contained and understandable without referring to external sources.

4. Submission Instructions

- Save the abstract as a Word document (.doc or .docx) or PDF file.
- Name the file as follows: `LastName_FirstName_Abstract`.
- Submit the abstract through the conference's online submission system by [insert deadline date].
