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Symposium Theme

In light of global changes affecting all fields and an information revolution transforming the world as we know it, there is a pressing need to develop and adapt policies and strategies to address these new realities. Universities and research laboratories play a pivotal role in providing insights, analyses, and forward-looking perspectives to tackle current and anticipated societal challenges, thereby contributing to civilizational progress.

Sports have emerged as a key enabler of sustainable development. Their significant role in fostering tolerance, respect, and empowerment—while advancing health, education, and social integration—has been widely recognized. Since the adoption of the United Nations General



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Assembly Resolution 70/1 in 2015, "Transforming Our World: The 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development," sports have proven to be a cost-effective and flexible tool for achieving Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The agenda explicitly acknowledges sports as a vital enabler of sustainable development, highlighting their cross-sectoral impact.

The intersection of sports and policy underscores the state's central role in shaping sports policies and infrastructure (stadiums, arenas, multi-sport halls, playgrounds, etc.), which are essential for youth engagement in amateur or professional sports. Beyond physical activity, sports serve as an educational tool, promoting socialization for children and inclusion for marginalized groups (e.g., the unemployed, disabled, and elderly). When leveraged effectively, sports can foster holistic development—health, intellect, ethics, and culture—thereby advancing SDGs.

Universities, across disciplines, bear a critical responsibility in addressing contemporary challenges at local and international levels. Algerian universities are expected to lead societal advancement through research and studies that promote stability, development, and progress.

Technical Guidelines

- Submissions must include the participant's full name, affiliation, rank/position, active phone number, and email.
- Titles must be clearly stated.
- Languages: Arabic, English, or French.
- Abstracts must be bilingual (at least two languages).
- Arabic submissions: Traditional Arabic font, size 14 (Simplified Arabic for titles).
- Foreign language submissions: Times New Roman, size 12 (titles: size 14).
- Selected papers will be published in indexed international journals.
- Other papers will be compiled in an ISBN-registered collective book and archived in recognized databases.
