II. The Problematic (Introduction)

The teaching of the Political Science and International Relations specialization in Algeria is of great importance, given the rapid changes in the international and regional arena, and the challenges facing the country in the context of these changes.

This specialization contributes to providing students with the necessary knowledge and skills, to understand and analyze complex international relations, formulate foreign policies, and participate in decision-making at national and international levels.

On the one hand, training students in political science fields is necessary for the country, as it provides decision-makers with the appropriate tools to understand the challenges facing society, and anticipate the interactions between various concerned parties. This is achieved through analyzing the complex issues facing society, such as poverty, unemployment, and corruption, and offering innovative and sustainable

solutions to these issues. Perhaps this is what the science of public policies provides as one of the sub-specialties in political science, which helps in evaluating the expected impact of public policies on various segments of society, ensuring the maximum utilization of available resources.

On the other hand, political science plays a pivotal role in understanding international relations, enabling the Algerian decision-maker to make sound strategic decisions, through accurate analysis of the security, economic, and political challenges facing Algeria in the region and the world. It also attempts to explore the available opportunities to strengthen Algeria's economic, political, and cultural relations with other countries.

However, despite this vital importance of the Political Science and International Relations specialization, it faces a set of complex challenges in Algeria that affect its importance and impact, starting with the necessity of updating the curricula to keep pace with the emerging challenges, and working to reduce the gap between the specialization and the job market ... and other challenges ... which presuppose joint efforts between the university and

economic and social partners in order to reach the final goal of the specialization , which is the formation and graduation of new generations of experts capable of providing understanding and suitable solutions to decision-makers regarding the various internal and external problems of the country.

Consequently, this national seminar aims to highlight the pivotal role represented by the teaching of the Political Science and International Relations specialization in Algeria , due to several considerations that primarily relate to the importance of qualifying and training university students at a high level , considering them the future national elite capable of confronting contemporary challenges and reinforcing the internal and external security of the country.
